

FSC® POLICY STATEMENT

Moore's Furniture Group design, manufacture, provision and install indoor furniture and associated products. The items are primarily constructed from melamine-faced chipboard, medium density fibre-board and other 'wood' products.

The Company, situated on the Thorp Arch Estate, Wetherby, West Yorkshire, is committed to the responsible procurement of all raw materials and components used in product manufacture including complying with the corresponding FSC (Forest Stewardship Council®) standards. Namely: FSC-STD-40-004 (for chain of custody certification) and our self-declaration regarding FSC-POL-01-004 (Policy for the Association of Organisations with FSC).

To achieve this, the Company shall:

- Train employees, and maintain training records for people who could influence the FSC system, from the initial sourcing of material through to invoicing
- Control the sourcing of FSC-certified material
- Have and operate a Responsible Procurement Policy
- Meet FSC requirements for the control of non-FSC certified wood / fibre
- Comply with FSC-STD-50-001 (requirements for use of the FSC trademarks by Certificate Holders)


The company shall not knowingly be directly or indirectly involved in the following unacceptable activities:

- Illegal logging or the trade in illegal wood or forest products
- Violation of traditional and human rights in forestry operations
- Destruction of high conservation values in forestry operations
- Significant conversion of forests to plantations or non-forest use
- Introduction of genetically modified organisms in forestry operations
- Violation of any of the ILO (International Labour Organisation) Core Conventions as defined in the ILO Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work
