

Modern Slavery Statement

In accordance with the requirements of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 (the "Act"), Moores Furniture Group Ltd ("MFG") is committed to ensuring that no form of slavery or human trafficking is taking place anywhere in its business or throughout its supply chains.

MFG expects that all its suppliers adhere to this commitment and in turn hold their own suppliers to the same standards.

Across our site in Wetherby and field based roles, MFG employs approximately 600 colleagues. We have in place robust procedures when vetting new colleagues to enable us to fulfil Right to Work obligations.

In line with our commitments, we have conducted the following actions:

- Reviewed MFG's Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy
- Published this Policy of the Online Colleague Portal
- Conducted Anti-Slavery e-learning to all appropriate colleagues
- Continue to work with suppliers to fulfil the commitments outlined in the Policy

As a result of these actions, MFG are satisfied that there is no evidence of any form of slavery or human trafficking within its business and will continue to work with suppliers to satisfy itself of the same for our supply chain.

As part of our commitment, we will continue to:

- Review and update our policy annually
- Roll out refresher e-learning to all appropriate colleagues
- Continue to work with suppliers to fulfil the commitments outlined in the Policy
